### LEAGUE RULES

All Canadian Curling Association Rules Of Curling For General Play applies except as noted below.

#### General

- The game will consist of 8 ends (6 ends for afternoon seniors). If a game is tied after 8 ends, an extra end will be played with 4 rocks per team (with a 2 rock free guard zone rule) (Seniors are exempt from the tie ruling). If still tied, Skips will draw to the button, with sweeping.
- You must play 6 ends for the game to be official.
- It is the winning team's Third's responsibility to record the results on the draw sheet by marking a "W" by the winning team's name on the day of the game. If the win is by default, mark winning team with "WD".
- A team must have a minimum of 3 players to commence play. Two of the three must be registered members of the team.

#### Forfeiture

- If a team is late, they are penalized 1 point and 1 end for the first 15 minutes and an additional point and end for each 10 minutes thereafter. After 35 minutes the team that is late forfeits the game.
- If a team cancels a game, for any reason, that game is deemed to be forfeited by the team that initiated the cancellation. The teams, upon agreement, can make up games and the forfeiture will be reversed.
- If the teams agree to a make-up game, it must be completed no later than 15 days from the original schedule date.
- In the event that the executive, via the league coordinator, due to impassable roads, plant breakdown or inclement weather, cancels a draw, the affected draw will be void and not replayed. Every effort will be made to notify the respective skips as far in advance as possible so that they may notify their team.

#### Time Limit

- If there is a second draw, all games must be completed within the 2 hour time limit, with the exception of the following:
  - There is a tie necessitating an extra end
  - No new end may be started later than 15 minutes before the end of the 2 hour limit.
  - An end already in progress may be completed.

### LEAGUE RULES Cont.

#### Spares

- Spares are permitted. Spares may play any position except skip.
- Spares must pay spare fees, unless they are paid members of that particular league. It is the responsibility of the skip to ensure the spare is informed of and pays the spare fee. If the spare is a not a member of that league but is a member of another league, they must pay spare fees. If they spare multiple times for that league, they only have to pay until they have paid the equivalent of the extra league (\$25). If the spare is not a member, they must always pay spare fees.
- There are two levels of spare fees. If the team has 4 or more registered players, the fee is \$5. If the team has less than 4 registered players, the fee is \$12.50.

#### Leagues

- The Senior League is an open fun league, Monday and Thursday afternoons. Teams are made up with a random draw each day. At the end of the season there is a competition to determine the winners of the Primeau Senior League trophy
- The Tuesday Ladies' League is a competitive league playing for the championship trophy at the end of the season. In the event of a tie at the end of the season, the head to head record will determine the winner. If they are still tied, an extra game must be played to determine the winner.
- The Wednesday Men's League is a competitive league playing for the championship trophy at the end of the season. In the event of a tie at the end of the season, the head to head record will determine the winner. If they are still tied, an extra game must be played to determine the winner.
- The Thursday Night Mercantile League is an open league that rotates positions every week (lead to second, second to vice, vice to skip, skip to lead etc.). It is a fun league playing for the championship trophy at the end of the season. In the event of a tie at the end of the season, the head to head record will determine the winner. If they are still tied, a draw to the button will be made with sweeping to determine the winner.
- Friday Night is a mixed league and the male and female players must alternate. It is a fun league playing for a championship trophy at the end of the season. In the event of a tie at the end of the season, the head to head record will determine the winner. If they are still tied, a draw to the button will be made with sweeping to determine the winner.
